



RETRIEVER TRAINING 2011

These are gundog training classes; please make sure your dog is capable of general obedience before bringing them to these classes. All dogs should be of a standard where they will sit quietly and return when called.

Due to the large numbers attending classes and the risks to livestock from dog faeces it is requested that all handlers pick up after their dogs at every venue. This will be strictly enforced, anyone not picking up or leaving poo bags behind will be asked not to attend training.

There will be four groups at training, young puppies Lucy Arnold, Older puppies (not ready for Novice) Celia Norris, Novice Kelvin Selway and Open Nick Coates.

Directions to Fonthill Bishop

From Warminster take A350 towards Shaftesbury, go under A303 at next traffic lights left to Hindon B3089 pass straight through Hindon in approx 2 miles turn right under stone arch, stay on this road, lake on left, at end turn left follow WWGS signs from here.

Directions to Horningsham, Nr Warminster

At Maiden Bradley turn off B3092 taking the Warminster road, approx 1 mile turn left towards Horningsham (unless you see WWGS signs, if so follow) the route will be sign posted WWGS from The Bath Arms Pub Horningsham

Directions to Orchardleigh

From Frome take A362 towards Radstock. After approx 2 miles the entrance to Orchardleigh will be on right WWGS signs from this point. From Radstock take A362 towards Frome through Buckland Dinham approx 2 miles entrance on left.

Directions to Trudoxhill

From Frome take A361 Shepton Mallet road. Just before Nunney Catch roundabout sign to Trudoxhill on left. Turn left, keep on through village, towards end of village pub on left, road forks right, keep right up the hill, entrance and WWGS signs will be on your left.
